An opportunity to join an exciting new venture bringing together church-based Christian youth and schools work to the young people of the Didcot area. ECHO is a partnership of seven local churches with the aim ***to disciple young people who make disciples through provisions that equip and release young people into mission, evangelism, and discipleship.***

ECHO workers are based in one of the partner churches and typically spend 50% of their time involved in youthwork within that partner church, and 50% working together with other ECHO staff across the town. In this role you will be the ***lead youth worker*** for **The King's Church, Didcot** ([www.thekingschurchdidcot.org](http://www.thekingschurchdidcot.org)), a thriving evangelical, charismatic, community church, engaging with the church's great group of young people and youth leaders. In addition, you will work in a team of ECHO youth workers engaging in schools work and other outreach and discipleship across the town.

The successful candidate will be a self-starter, creative, motivated, self-aware, organised, able to work in team, lead others and form good working relationships with people from schools and churches across Didcot. They will have a desire to see young people discover Jesus for themselves and grow in the sharing the Good News with their generation. To enable them to fully integrate youth work with church community, they would be expected to be (or become) a committed member of The King's Church.

Appropriate study leave will be provided and additional study (e.g. theology and/or ministry) can be considered in conjunction with this role.
